

Changing Major to the College of Engineering within Qatar University

Students who are interested in transferring to the college of engineering from other colleges within Qatar University must fulfil the following requirements to apply to the College of Engineering. These requirements are a way of assessing their academic abilities and ensuring they will be able to cope with the level of study within the college

❖ Change of Major “Minimum” Requirements:

1. The student satisfies CENG admission requirements at the time of initial admission to QU.
2. Students who did not meet the minimum CENG admission requirements (Highs School GPA) at the time of initial admission to Qatar University may apply to change their academic major after Completing a minimum number of 24 credit hours with a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.5/4.00
3. Academic Standing: Good Standing
4. Obtaining a full exemption or passed the **Foundation program**.

Important Notes:

- 1- In special cases and based on the availability within the foundation program, the college may accept some students in the foundation program for passing the English and Mathematics requirements.
- 2- Students changed major to College of Engineering are accepted in **General Engineering or Engineering Foundation**. Students must apply later to declare their major through the “Declaring Major” process, taking into consideration the programs requirements.
- 3- General Physics for Engineering I “PHYS 191” will not be substituted with General Physics I “PHYS 101” for students transferring to college of engineering, effective from Fall 2025
- 4- Change of major is extremely competitive and is subject to the capacity of the college; satisfying the above requirements does not guarantee admission into the college or the major.
